Re: Dress Code for Burnt Cabin

Dear Camper,

Thank you for choosing to be a camper at Burnt Cabin Christian Camp. We hope and pray you come back every time you can. With that in mind, here are some changes in the **dress code** you need to be aware of:

- 1) During the day, everyone must wear standard round neck t-shirts or high V necks or pullover polo style shirts. You are allowed to roll up the sleeves. Logos associated with drinking establishments or other worldly messages are not allowed.
- 2) Shorts must be no higher than the short side of a dollar bill (2.5 inches) above the knee when standing. Jeans and Capri pants are also acceptable.
- 3) During evening hours such as worship, girls are allowed to wear dresses or skirts as long as they are shorts length or longer. Tops must cover as much as a t-shirt.

These are “no tolerance” rules, and are non-negotiable. In other words, campers must abide by the dress code or be sent home. The main reason for the dress code is to promote decency and a spiritual mindset during camp. This really helps campers focus on the spiritual aspects of camp without as much distraction from the physical aspects.
