<p>Note: All examples of conversion include baptism. Romans 6:1-11, Matt 28:18-19, and Mark 16:15-16, Acts 2:38 stresses importance of baptism. John 3:1-5 Jesus tells Nicodemus we must be born of water and Spirit. II Peter 2:20-22 says it's better to have never known God's will than to know and then turn away. Romans 10:9-13 Jew AND Gentile can now call on the Name of the Lord (no longer only Jews) Luke 6:46 (Why call Jesus your Lord, and then refuse to obey Him?) Matthew 7:21 Not everyone who says to me Lord, Lord will enter the kingdom... Matthew 16:27 He will reward each person according to what he has done.</p>
