You will make lots of plans in your lifetime; but God's plan for you to go to Heaven is the most important plan you will ever follow.

The New Testament Plan of Salvation requires that you:

- 1) HEAR the good news of Jesus Christ, and that you
- 2) <u>BELIEVE</u> in your heart that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and that He came to this Earth to live as a man to show you how to live, and that He as the perfect sacrifice died for your sins and was raised by God on the 3rd day so that you could have the hope of eternal life in Heaven, and that you
- 3) <u>REPENT</u> of your sins at the age you understand sin and right from wrong. And by repenting, you make the decision to TURN AWAY, or make a U-TURN from sin and living for the world, and decide to live for GOD instead of the world (Luke 6:46)... and that you
- 4) <u>CONFESS</u> with your mouth what you BELIEVE in your heart... and that you are
- 5) BAPTIZED (IMMERSED) to wash away your sins... and that you
- 6) STAND FIRM to the end as you grow spiritually by adding to your faith Godly values. (2 Peter 1:3-11)

Believing is the "key ingredient" to God's plan of salvation. The remaining steps are to be followed only if belief is present. Otherwise, obedience to the remaining commandments is nothing but you going through the motions. Without belief, they mean nothing.
