

Burnt Cabin Christian Camp

Camp Purpose: We want BCCC to be a place for spiritual training; a facility where youth may come to a deeper understanding of God, to know Him more, and to apply His will in their lives. Activities at the camp are designed to bring kids closer to Christ. We promote Christian friendships, good morals, spiritual values and disciplines such as prayer, Bible study, and participation in the Lord's church.

You're Invited: Teenweek is for campers who have completed 6th-12th grades. Kids Camp is for campers who have completed 1st-5th grades. BCCC admits children of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all rights, privileges and activities available to campers. Rules of acceptance and participation in the camp are the same for everyone.

Cost: Camp fees pay for lodging, meals, pool upkeep, camper accident insurance, additional drinks and snacks (canteen), and general maintenance and upgrades.

Safety First: BCCC conducts all activities under adult supervision. A lifeguard will be present during swim time. A nurse or other qualified volunteer is available for onsite first aid. The nearest hospitals are in Tahlequah.

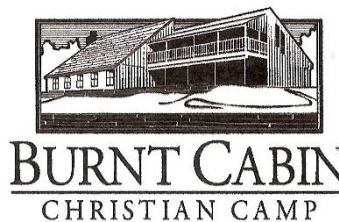
Phone Calls: Calls home are allowed only for emergencies.

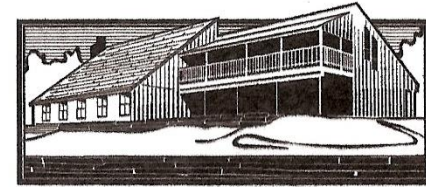
